Mr. Lai had his drug bills all over the table. Having been subsidized to pay off the treatment, he recovered from cancer and gave back to the Fund to help other people suffered from cancer.

A Fund Revived a Cancer Patient's Life

As a healthy, cigarette and alcohol-free 62-year-old man, Mr. Lai was diagnosed with terminal lung cancer three years ago. "It shook my mind! The first thing that came into my mind was, if I really die this way, who is going to take care of my 90-year-old mom..."

Thinking that his mother would be left alone, Mr. Lai was determined to fight back. The doctor advised Mr. Lai that chemotherapy could help reverse the condition. However, chemotherapy drug costs \$4,000 per injection, and 17 to 18 injections were required for each treatment course. As a taxi driver, he had no way to afford such huge medical expenses as he would have no income at all if he did not work.

Fortunately, upon referral from medical social worker, Mr. Lai successfully applied for "YOT Chong Sok Un Medical Fund (cancer aid)", and over \$70,000 of funding was granted for his treatment. After more than one year of treatment, his medical condition was stabilized in a desirable way.

"I could never imagine that, the fund that I once donated money to would save my life when I felt the most desperate ever. Therefore, I recently donated \$1,500 of my saving to the Fund. I hope there would be more people in the society donating, and bringing hopes to other helpless cancer patients' life!

- 1.Recommendation made by a medical officer of the Department of Clinical Oncology or Medicine & Geriatrics of Tuen Mun Hospital/ United Christian Hospital/ Queen Elizabeth Hospital/ Princess Margaret Hospital/ Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital/ Queen Mary Hospital
- 2.Financial assessment and a subsidy amount recommended by a medical social work officer of Tuen Mun Hospital/ United Christian Hospital/ Queen Elizabeth Hospital/ Princess Margaret Hospital/ Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital/ Queen Mary Hospital
- 3.The application will be examined by YOT Chong Sok Un Medical Fund (cancer aid) in the final stage
- 4.Tuen Mun Hospital/ United Christian Hospital/ Queen Elizabeth Hospital/ Princess Margaret Hospital/ Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital/ Queen Mary Hospital purchases the drug on patient's behalf and start treatment





The YOT Chong Sok Un Medical Fund (cancer aid) was formally established on December 15, 2007 to provide financial aid to underprivileged cancer patients from 6 public hospitals with oncology centres, including Tuen Mun Hospital, United Christian Hospital, Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Princess Margaret Hospital, Pamela Youde Nethersole Eastern Hospital and Queen Mary Hospital in a upper cash limit of \$100,000 per person in acquisition of self-financed drugs listed in the Hospital Authority Drug Formulary. By April 2019, the fund has subsidized nearly 7,000 patients and which valued over 110 million Hong Kong dollars.
